- face masks indoors
- four-player max per court
- staggered court start times

- treatment by Biodome for additional disinfection of surfaces and long-term antimicrobial protection
- contact-tracing follow-up if we learn of potential on-court exposure during the CDC-defined window of 48 hours prior to onset of symptoms and/or a positive COVID test result

When you visit JPTC...

- Please provide full names and contact info of each player when calling to reserve courts / schedule lessons or upon arrival for play.
- Sanitize or thoroughly wash your hands before or, if necessary, upon entering JPTC.
- Bring your own water bottle & towel. Use the hands-free water bottle filler when necessary.
- Provide your own tennis balls for general play (people from the same household may share). Ball machine practice balls will be provided by JPTC. Teaching pros will provide tennis balls for lessons.
